Classical Solo

Performance Requirements

 Competitors must perform one (1) or two (2) contrasting selections from the current Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) or Conservatory Canada (CC) syllabus for their particular instrument.

Euphonium, French Horn, Trombone, and Tuba students may select music not found in the syllabus as long as their teacher has helped identify the approximate level for their selections (especially for levels 3,5,7).

RCM Syllabi (Euphonium, French Horn, Trombone, Trumpet, Tuba)
CC Trumpet Syllabus (only Trumpet Syllabus available)

 Provide all necessary details of your selections, including accurate timing. "To Be Decided" in any field will not be accepted.
 The only exception to this is the field labelled "Movement/Musical". If your piece does not have any movements please put "none".

Diploma vs Open

<u>Diploma</u>: Competitors **who have not completed** their Associate level examination **OR** have been **studying for less than 2 years** at an Associate level. University performance majors may not enter this class.

<u>Open</u>: Competitors **who have completed** their Associate level examination **OR** have been **studying for more than 2 years** at an Associate level. University performance majors must enter this class.

Provincial Qualifications

All Brass Solo Classes and Brass Concerto Classes at Provincials Competition (OMFA) are held **live** in Kitchener/Waterloo in June (9-14) 2025.

<u>Level 1 - 10</u>: Up to three (3) competitors per Grade Level will be recommended <u>Open Level</u>: Up to four (4) competitors between Diploma class and Open class, will be recommended.

Music Festival 2025 Brass - Solo Syllabus

Brass Concerto will be a separate class at Provincials. If you performed a concerto in your Solo Class, you may be recommended for Provincials in both Brass Concerto Class and Brass Solo Class but may not perform the same concerto in both classes.

Competitors must perform two selections and receive a minimum mark of 85 in order to receive a recommendation. Open level competitors may perform 2 or 3 selections.

Only students who receive a recommendation may compete at OMFA Provincials.

- Competitor Age is as of December 31st, 2024.
- Competitors must perform one (1) selection from any of the following genres: pop, pop/folk, R & B, soul, rock, alternative, indie, jazz or country.
- Provide all necessary details of your selections, including accurate timing. "To Be Decided" in any field will not be accepted.
 The only exception to this is the field labelled "Movement/Musical". If your piece does not have any movements please put "none".

Provincial Qualifications

Up to three (3) competitors from each Age Category will be recommended for the Provincial competition (OMFA) held **live** in Kitchener/Waterloo in June (9-14) 2025.

Competitors must receive a minimum mark of 85 in order to receive a recommendation.
