Performance Requirements

- Competitors must perform one (1) or two (2) contrasting selections from the current Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) or Conservatory Canada (CC) syllabus for their particular instrument.

Euphonium, French Horn, Trombone, and Tuba students may select music not found in the syllabus as long as their teacher has helped identify the approximate level for their selections (especially for levels 3,5,7).
