Classical Solo

Performance Requirements

 Competitors must perform one to two (1-2) contrasting selections (1-3 for Open Class) from the current Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) or Conservatory Canada (CC) syllabus for their particular instrument.

RCM Syllabi (Bassoon, Clarinet, Flute, Oboe, Recorder, Saxophone)
CC Flute Syllabus
CC Clarinet Syllabus

 Provide all necessary details of your selections, including accurate timing. "To Be Decided" in any field will not be accepted.
 The only exception to this is the field labelled "Movement/Musical". If your piece does not have any movements please put "none".

Diploma vs Open

<u>Diploma</u>: Competitors **who have not completed** their Associate level examination **OR** have been **studying for less than 2 years** at an Associate level. University performance majors may not enter this class.

<u>Open</u>: Competitors **who have completed** their Associate level examination **OR** have been **studying for more than 2 years** at an Associate level. University performance majors must enter this class.

Provincial Qualifications

<u>Level 1 - 5</u>: Up to three (3) competitors per Grade Level will be recommended for the Provincial competition (OMFA) held **virtually**. Deadline to register after receiving recommendation is May 12, 2025.

<u>Level 6 - 10</u>: Up to three (3) competitors per Grade Level will be recommended for the Provincial competition (OMFA) held **live** in Kitchener/Waterloo in June (9-14). <u>Open Level</u>: Up to four (4) competitors between Diploma class and Open class, will be recommended for Provincial (OMFA) held **live** in Kitchener/Waterloo in June (9-14).



<u>Flute and Reed Instruments will be separated at the Provincials</u>. There will be 3 Flute recommendations and 3 Reed Instrument recommendations given out per Grade Level and 4 each for Open Level.

<u>Woodwind Concerto will be a separate class at Provincials</u> and All Levels (Split by Age Categories) are held **Live**. If you performed a concerto in your Solo Class, you may be recommended for Provincials in both Woodwind Concerto class and Flute or Reed Solo class but **may not perform the same concerto in both classes**.

Competitors must perform two selections (Open level competitors may perform 2 or 3 selections) and receive a minimum mark of 85 in order to receive a recommendation.

Only students who receive a recommendation may compete at OMFA Provincials.

- Competitor Age is as of December 31st, 2024.
- Competitors must perform one (1) selection from any of the following genres: pop, pop/folk, R & B, soul, rock, alternative, indie, jazz or country.
- Provide all necessary details of your selections, including accurate timing. "To Be Decided" in any field will not be accepted.
 The only exception to this is the field labelled "Movement/Musical". If your piece does not have any movements please put "none".

Provincial Qualifications

In each Age Category, up to three (3) competitors will be recommended for the Provincial competition (OMFA) held **live** in Kitchener/Waterloo in June (9-14).

Competitors must receive a minimum mark of 85 in order to receive a recommendation.
